

## What happens after you submit your forms

- 1. You will receive a call within seven days of receipt of the patient information from a member of our nursing staff to:
  - Help you pick a day and time for your colonoscopy
  - Give an overview of the procedure and the procedure day
  - Review anesthesia questions with you
  - Answer any questions you have
- 2. On our website, <u>www.FallHillGastro.com</u> you will be able to find forms reviewing the preparation instructions, diet instructions, and directions to the Endoscopy Center.
  - Your prescription for the laxative preparation will be faxed to your pharmacy.
  - Consent forms for the Colonoscopy and Anesthesia will be sent to you for your review, but you will sign them at the Endoscopy Center on the day of your procedure.
- 3. Two days before your colonoscopy, the endoscopy nurse will call you again to confirm the appointment date and time, answer questions and review instructions.
- 4. You need to arrive at the endoscopy center one hour prior to your scheduled procedure time.
- 5. On the day of the procedure please bring your picture identification and your current insurance card.
- 6. You may receive a bill from Fall Hill Gastroenterology, Somnia Anesthesia group, and Theranostics Pathology Services.
- 7. As you leave you will receive a full report of your procedure. The results of any biopsies will be sent to you by letter when available.
